Compliance with EU Directive 94/62/EC on Packaging and Packaging Waste

Spansion is a manufacturer of flash memory products.

European Parliament and Council Directive 94/62/EC of 20 December 1994 on packaging and packaging waste requires the marking of packaging with an appropriate recycle category, the recycling of packaging waste, and limits the total concentration of four heavy metals to less than 100 ppm. (See article 11.) Spansion packaging materials meet these requirements.

Spansion verifies compliance by collecting analytical data from third party laboratories reporting the total concentration of the four heavy metals. These reports are available upon the request of customers for the packing materials used in shipping Spansion products to them.
